**Abstract Submission:** Submitted abstract should be in English, including title, author(s) and organization(s), mailing address and zip code, e-mail address. It is recommended to include as much as possible unpublished scientific research. The abstracts will be included in the e-Proceedings and will not be publicly published. Authors will be notified of the acceptance of their submissions after evaluation by the

Organizing Committee. Submission Deadline: September 15, Sunday, 2024. Late submission or submission without registration will not be accepted.

**Poster Display:** Posters will be placed in the designated area in the meeting hall. The size board: 90cm (width) x 120cm (height). The title, author's name, institution/affiliation, city and zip/postal code should be indicated on the poster.

Outstanding posters will be awarded by the Organizing Committee.

**Venue:** 47 Nanchang Road, Huangpu District

**Departure from: Shanghai Railway Station**

Subway: Take Line 3 or Line 4 to Zhongshan Park Station, transfer to Line 2 towards Nanjing East Road Station, then transfer to Line 10 towards Xintiandi Station. Exit at Exit 4 and walk for about 10 minutes to reach the destination.

Taxi: The distance to the Science Hall is 5.3 kilometers, with an estimated travel time of about 30 minutes and a cost of approximately 40 yuan.

### **Departure from: Hongqiao Railway Station, Hongqiao International Airport**

Subway: Take Line 2 to Nanjing East Road Station, then transfer to Line 10 towards Xintiandi Station. Exit at Exit 4 and walk for about 10 minutes to reach the destination.

Taxi: The distance to the Science Hall is 21 kilometers, with an estimated travel time of about 45 minutes and a cost of approximately 80 yuan.

### **Departure from: Shanghai Pudong International Airport**

Subway: Take the Maglev train to Longyang Road Station, or Line 2 to Nanjing East Road Station, then transfer to Line 10 towards Xintiandi Station. Exit at Exit 4 and walk for about 10 minutes to reach the destination.

Taxi: The distance to the Science Hall is 47 kilometers, with an estimated travel time of about 60 minutes and a cost of approximately 180 yuan.
